EXHIBITOR and PROJECT RULES:

- All youth are required to attend 2 educational sessions and one (1) "hands-on" session; project meetings, field trips, area science days, and other educational sessions involving goats are acceptable. If there are questions, call Cindy or Donna at 608-783-8181.
- All goats must be enrolled in Scrapie Program. ID numbers are free and available from the state vet. All animals must have a scrapie ear tag or tattoo. ADGA tattoos are acceptable as long as they are registered with the Scrapie Program.
- A list of your goats, their Scrapie number and copy of your Scrapie letter must be given to the superintendent. All animals will be checked.

ANIMAL EXHIBIT RULES:

- Any doe with horns entered in any class, items 1-9 in the Dairy Goat breeds or will not be allowed to show.
- Any goat exhibit in the Meat/Pet breeds are allowed to have horns.
- Any doe 24 months of age or over that has never freshened may not be shown.
- All animals must be inspected by before unloading.
- Ages of goats shall be determined as of the opening day of the fair. See the General Regulations for age definitions.
- See Animal Health Rules for goats at exhibition.
