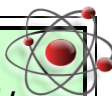


DEPARTMENT 10 JUNIOR ANIMAL / VETERINARY SCIENCE / SMALL PETS

All Veterinary Science education items for display/posters should be dropped off at the New Youth building. Look for the Animal Science drop off sign. Pick up posters and homemade items at the New Youth Building on Sunday.

1. Please secure pictures to display / poster.
2. Cite all sources.
3. Posters should be 14"x22" in size
4. Posters will be displayed in a space where there is room and using staples or will be hung.
5. All homemade requires a 3"x5" explanation card. Here explain the materials used, how it was put together and how long did it take to complete. What did you learn from this? What was the most challenge you had? A picture taken of the process can be used instead of the card, but still will need to answer the above questions.

1. Poster on parts of an animal.
2. Poster on 5 different breeds and at least 5 characteristics of each animal

5. Any other animal poster
6. Homemade furniture (3x5 explanation card)
7. Homemade toy (3x5 explanation card)
8. Homemade dish (3x5 explanation card)

CLASS B – SMALL PETS

Any pet bird, fish, cavy (guinea pig), gerbil, mouse, rat or other small animal identified as a youth project can be exhibited as a small pet. Although the animal may be domesticated and possess a special permit; no wild life or exotics will be allowed for the protection of the community.

Open to all small pet members. An exhibit includes one or two pets in good condition at time of show or no premium will be paid.

Junior Cats and Small Pets are shown on the Wednesday of the fair at 3:00 PM behind the small animal barn under the tent. Rain site to be determined. Animals are shown and taken home after the show as no animals will stay on the grounds.

All pets and cats will be health checked by the Superintendent before the 3:00 PM start. Please arrive 30 minutes or earlier to complete the check-in.

Please bring a 5"x7" poster board with a picture of you and your animal(s). Attach the fair entry tag to the poster board. Use AMPLE amounts of RUBBER CEMENT or PERMANENT double-sided tape for attaching your photos. This will keep them from falling off during the fair.

After this show is completed, the ribbon will be attached to the poster board and displayed. Pick up will be at the New Youth Building on Sunday.
